## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1302

WHEREAS, Elden E. Wilkerson of Sells and Joseph E. Sestack of Phoenix have applied to the Tribe for permission to sub-lease from the Indian Casis Trading Post the Indian Casis Service Station on Topawa Road in Sells, and

WHEREAS, the said Service Station is now under lease from the Papago Tribe to the said Indian Casis Trading Post and the said Trading Post is joining in the within application to the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the applicants have been interviewed by the Papago Council and have been found competent and suitable to obtain said sub-lease, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council is desirous of having the gross receipts of the said Service Station added in with the gross receipts of the Trading Post in computing the fee to be paid to the Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT HE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby approves and authorises the sub-lease of the said Indian Casis Service Station to the said Elden E. Wilkerson and Joseph E. Sestack for the period of time remaining in the original lease.

IET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby orders and directs that the gross receipts of the said Service Station are to be added with the gross receipts of the Trading Post in computing the fee to be paid to the Tribe in accordance with the provisions of the existing lease between the Indian Casis Trading Post and the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 3, 1963, with a vote of 19 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
