## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1313

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Secton 2, of the Papago Tribal Law and Order Code prevides for the appointment of an Associate Judge for Sells, and

WHEREAS, Joe Thomas, a member of the Papago Tribe, residing in the Village of Ventana on the Papago Reservation, has served in the past on various occasions as Associate Judge in Sells and has performed his duties in a satisfactory and praiseworthy manner, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has duly and thoroughly considered the matter of this appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESCLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that it recommends to the Bureau of Indian Affairs that Joe Themas be appointed Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Court, to serve on such occasion or eccasions when his services as Associate Judge are required, as a salary of \$10.00 per day or fraction of a day, whenever he so serves as said Associate Judge, said appointment to be effective for a period of two years, and to be paid from Tribal Funds budgeted for the Associate Judge.

The Feregeing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papage Council on June 7, 1963, with a vote of 17 for, 0 against, and 2 not voting, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a), Section 3 (b), and Section 3 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to reaccission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
