NOT SUBJECT TO REVIEW OR APPROVAL.

WHEREAS, at a meeting held May 30, 1963, at which a quorum was present, the Gila Bend District Council approved a Budget for the 1964 fiscal year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed Budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.


NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Gila Bend District Budget for the 1964 fiscal year be approved as follows:


Provision for hauling water 5 days per week at \$8.00 per day for 52 weeks	\$ 2,080.00
Car Repairs when necessary	100.00
General and regular needs and purposes of the District	500.00
	<u>\$2,680.00</u>

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED; that the Chairman of the Gila Bend District Council or his authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 12, 1963, with a vote of 20 for, 0 against, and 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by ~~Section 3 (a) 2~~ and ~~Section 3 (h)~~ of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
