WHEREAS, at a meeting held June 9, 1963, at which a quorum was present, the Sif Oidak District Council approved a Budget for the 1964 fiscal year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed Budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.


NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Sif Oidak District Budget for the 1964 fiscal year be approved as follows:


Office, Supplies, Gasoline and Oil, Feed for Livestock, Medicine for Livestock, Pump Repair, Lumber and Bolts for Corrals, and Groceries for Cowboys	\$ 1,500.00
Boundary Fencing	2,000.00
Miscellaneous Expense	500.00
TOTAL	<u>\$ 4,000.00</u>

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Sif Oidak District Council or his duly authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 12, 1963, with a vote of 22 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by ~~Section 3 (a)~~ and Section ~~2 + 3 (1)~~ of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
