**RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL**

RES. NO. 1331

WHEREAS, Edward J. Sullivan, Administrative Assistant to the Tribe, has applied for an increase in his salary from the present figure of \$6,000.00 per year plus \$1,000.00 expenses, and

WHEREAS, the workload in the Tribal Office has increased considerably during the past year for the reason that the business of the Tribe is expanding in all directions, and

WHEREAS, the personal business of the individual Papagos has increased greatly of late and the Administrative Assistant has devoted a great portion of his time to the problems and matters of these Papagos, and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Assistant is able to assist in legal matters because of his legal education and training, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sullivan's work has been entirely satisfactory and the operation of the Tribal Office has been gratifying, and

WHEREAS, provision has been made in the Tribal 1964 Fiscal Year Budget for this increase, and

WHEREAS, the District Councils of Sells, Baboquivari and Chinle Kuk Districts have passed a Resolution approving an increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby grants and approves an increase in the salary of the Administrative Assistant to the Tribe to \$6,500.00 per year plus \$1,000.00 expenses, commencing on November 1st, 1963, and that the Tribal Officers are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into a contract of employment with the said Edward J. Sullivan for the period of one year at the increased salary figure.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on October 11, 1963, with a vote of 16 for and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
