DESCLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WEEREAS, Edward J. Sullivan, Administrative Assistant to the Bribe, has applied for an increase in his sulary free the present figure of \$6,000.00 per year plus \$1,000.00 expenses, and

WEEREAS, the workload in the Brital Office has increased considerably during the past year for the reason that the business of the Brite is expanding in all directions, and

VERNEAS, the personal business of the individual Papages has increased greatly of late and the Administrative Assistant has devoted a great portion of his time to the problems and matters of those Papages, and

WEINEAS, the Administrative Assistant is able to assist in legal matters because of his legal education and training, and

WREDEAS, Mr. Sullivan's work has been entirely satisfactory and the operation of the Tribal Office has been gratifying, and

WEENERS, provision has been made in the Tribal 1964 Fiscal Tear Budget for this increase, and

VESREAS, the District Councils of Sells, Sebequivari and Chakut Euk Districts have passed a Resolution approving an impresse.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT HE RESOLVED, that the Papage Council hereby grants and approves an increase in the galary of the Administrative Assistant to the Bribe to \$6,500.00 per year plus \$1,000.00 expenses, semmenting on November lat, 1963, and that the Bribal Officers are hereby authorized and expowered to enter into a contract of exployment with the said Edward J. Sullivan for the period of one year at the increased salary figure.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papage Council on Ceteber 11, 1963, with a vote of 16 for end 0 against, during a secting at which a quorus was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 5 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papage Pribe ratified by the Tribe on Becomber 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papage Agency and is subject to remainsion by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papage Tribe.
