

RESOLUTION
OF
PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

REG. NO. 1401

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs erected a building in So La, Arizona for the purpose of Barber, Beauty Shop, Public rest rooms, combined, and

WHEREAS, the building have being completed in December, 1966 and now ready for occupancy.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the building be accepted as one of its building from the Bureau of Indian Affairs,

PROVIDED: that the Papago Tribal Council be responsible for maintenance, repairs, upkeep and receive all rental payments from building.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 2, 1967 with a vote of 19 for, and 0 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 924), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
