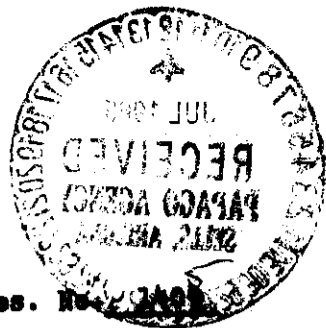

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Res. No. 1965

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council is interested in maintaining adequate financial records in connection with the financial operation of the Papago Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Council is desirous of having adequate books and records maintained in the Tribal Office, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have a professional accountant supervise the accounting records of the Council, and

WHEREAS, it is desirous for the Tribe to have an audit of all of the books and records of the trading posts on the Reservation to determine whether they are complying with the Papago Tribal Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, Victor and Robert Arida dba Victor H. Arida & Co. have completed a satisfactory audit of one trading post, to wit: Indian Oasis Trading Post, and

WHEREAS, Victor and Robert Arida dba Victor H. Arida & Co. have agreed to enter into a contract with the Papago Tribal Council for the sum of \$1,200.00 per year payable at the rate of \$100.00 per month.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby orders and directs the Tribal Officials to enter into a written agreement with Victor and Robert Arida dba Victor H. Arida & Co., accountants. Said written agreement is hereto annexed. In accordance with the terms and conditions of said annexed agreement, the Tribal Officials are further ordered to execute the annexed agreement on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on May 7th, 1965, with a vote of 19 for and 0 against, with 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2(b) and Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1964. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
