Gaseline and Oil Food for Livesteck Medicine Oroceries for Round-ups 31,500.00 Repairing Pumps Office Supplies Lumber and Bolts for Remairing Corrals Payment for all Matrict Meetings 936.00 Telephone (District) 341.49 240.00 Electricity for Mater Pumps Gaseline and Repairs for Vehicles to Tribal Council Meetings 500.00 District Boundry Fencing 1.000.00 500.00 Miscellaneous Expenses \$5,017.00

Let it be further Resolved, that the Chairman of the Sif Oidak Estrict Council or his duly authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papage Council on July 2, 1965, with a vote of 18 for, O against, 4 not voting, during a meeting at which a querum was present, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article 5 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papage Tribe ratified by the Tribe on Recember 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 1° of the Act of June 18, 1934.
