

RESOLUTIONS
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 1107

WHEREAS, at a special meeting held June 26, 1945, at which a quorum was present, the Hohokaviari District Council approved a budget for the 1946 fiscal year and submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and benefit of the Hohokaviari District.

Therefore, it is Resolved by the Papago Tribal Council that the Hohokaviari District Budget for the 1946 fiscal year be approved as follows:

Gasoline Pump Operation	1,000.00
Repairs Pump Engine	500.00
Total	\$1,500.00

Let it be further Resolved, that Margaret Ruth Antone of the Hohokaviari District be authorized to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amount specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 2, 1945, with a vote of 20 for, and 0 against, and 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article 5 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 4, 1937, (stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
