

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAYAGO COUNCIL.

No. 1407

WHEREAS, at a special meeting held June 26, 1945, at which a quorum was present, the Nambiquara District Council approved a budget for the 1944 fiscal year and submitted it to the Payago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Payago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and benefit of the Nambiquara District.

Therefore, it is resolved by the Payago Tribal Council that the Nambiquara District Budget for the 1944 fiscal year be approved as follows:

Gasoline Pump Operation	\$600.00
Gasoline Pump Engine	100.00
Total	\$7,000.00

Let it be further resolved, that Margaret Ruth Antone of the Nambiquara District be authorized to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amount specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Payago Council on July 2, 1945, with a vote of 20 for, and 0 against, and 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article 5 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Payago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 4, 1937, (stat. 981) pursuant to Section 14 of the Act of June 18, 1936.
