## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 1408

WHEREAS, the Gila Bend District Council has approved a Budget for the 1966 fiscal year at a meeting held July 1, 1965 at which a quorum was present and has submitted it to the Papage Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Paparo Tribal Council has commidered the proposed Budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE PESOIVER, by the Paparo Tribal Council that the Cils Bend District Budget for the 1966 fiscal year he approved as follows:

Provision for hauling water 5 days per week	
at \$5.00 per day for 52 weeks	\$2,080.00
Pepsirs to Stephen Pablo's truck	500.00
Miscellaneous Expenses of the District	600.00
Total	\$ 3,180.00

Let it be further resolved, that the Chairman of the Gila Bend Mistrict Council or his authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 2, 1945, withou vote of 17 for, 0 against, and 5 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, persuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article 5 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Fanamo Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 14 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
