

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 1409

WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Council has approved a Budget for the 1966 fiscal year, and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the District had a balance of \$7,095.46 on June 30, 1965, the end of the fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed Budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Council that the Chukut Kuk Budget for the 1966 fiscal year be approved as follows:

Let it be further resolved, that the District Treasurer or his authorized representative be authorized and permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes up to the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 2, 1965, with a vote of 18 for, and 2 against, during a meeting at which a quorum was present pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Sec. 2 (f) of Article 5 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1934, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 14 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
