WHEREAS, although the total estimated Income expends by only \$2,909.60 the total estimated expenditures, the Council believes that during the course of the 1966 fiscal year the Tribe will is the recipient of new incomes, incomes from projects and enterprises which at the mement are either not in exichaged or are in a mem-producing state.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED; that the Papage Council hereby approves and adopts in its entirely the 1966 fiscal year budget of the Papage Tribe as herewith presented.

Let it be further resolved, that the Treasurer of the Papage Bribe be authorized to sign purchase orders and voughers in the assumts provided in the above Budget against the properly disignated accounts. The feregoing Recolution was duly enacted by the Papage Council es <u>Aumet 6</u>, 1965, with a vote of <u>18</u> for, <u>0</u> against, and <u>1</u> not voting, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council be Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papage Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1937 (State 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papage Agency and is subject to registion by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papage Tribe.
