

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Res. No. 1416

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on July 7, 1965, at which a quorum was present, the Gu Achi District Council approved a budget for the 1966 fiscal year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Papago Tribal Council that the Gu Achi District budget for the 1966 fiscal year be approved as follows:

1. Transportation expenses to attend meetings	\$100.00
2. Miscellaneous expenses	25.00
3. Reserve Fund (subject to District approval)	78.60
Total Budget	<u>\$203.60</u>

Let it be further Resolved, that the District Chairman or his authorized representative be authorized and permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 6, 1965, with a vote of 21 for, 0 against, and 0 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
