

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council and District members held a meeting on July 24, and 28, 1965 to discuss the acquisition of land and rights of way required in connection with the construction of a new boarding and day school at Santa Rosa Village, and

WHEREAS, the said District Council and members did approve of a site for such construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby grant permission to the Bureau of Indian Affairs the use, management, and control of land located north of the Santa Rosa Wash and south of the Sif Oidak, and Gu Achi District boundary fence, and west of the reservation route #15, consisting of a minimum 120 acres plus additional acreage for road ways as well as such rights of way as may be required for well sites and pipe lines.

The foregoing permission for the use of this land shall remain in force and effect only so long as the Bureau of Indian Affairs maintain a school at this designated site.

Be it further Resolved, that if for the purpose for which this land was set aside is not utilized after a reasonable period, the management and control of the said land will revert back to the Gu Achi District.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 6, 1965, with a vote of 19 for, 0 against, and 2 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (c & k) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
