RESCLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

286. NO. 1430

WHERMAS, Clifford A. Brane, who operates the Covered Vella Trading Feat at Covered Vella has not paid my part of the Tribal three per cent (35) sales tex levied on all news-Indian traders on the Papage Reservation, and

MERIAS, It appears from time to time that there has been various complaints brought to the attention of the Papage Tribal Council concerning Clifford A. Brace. One is that Mr. Brace hired a Papage girl for three dellars (\$3.00) per day to do bely sitting, work in the store and unload groceries brought from tous, a wage far below the astional wage scale. Second is that Mr. Brace sold pastry that was already moled and he refuse to refund the buyer and it is also reported that on several occasions has sold spuiled milk. Third instance reported is that when people pay their bills assisting groceries he adds the paid bill onto the new one. The geople that him him in the Covered Wells area have a long walk on fact to the state to buy groceries and many times they buy a large quantity that is impossible to carry home, they try to ask Mr. Brace to take that him him is his pickup truck, but he refuses to do so and goth delightable about it. There is also certain reports of him from Spagage arising people up from bed trying to sell them groceries.

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT ME RESOLVED, By the Papage Tribal Council that in view of the above fasts the Council eagefully considered it and discussed it in a great length of time and same to the conclusion that Mr. Brace is without an expuse to pay the Tribe three per cent (3%) sales tax, which every Ather trader on the Reservation pays and the complaints against him stated above do exist, therefore the Papage Tribal Council will not renow him trader's license.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the Tribal Attermey and the Papago Agency be notified to take any action mesonsary.

The foregoing resolution was duly enseted by the Papago Council on November 12,1965, with a vete of 18 fer, against, and not voting, during a meeting at which a querum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Seumeil by meetion 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Lams of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Becretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
