

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1431

WHEREAS, the U. S. Indian Public Health Service turned over to the Papago Agency three (3) pickett houses located on Tribal land, west of Santa Rosa School and south of Santa Rosa Public Health Clinic in the village of Santa Rosa in Gu-Achi District, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Agency then in turn gave the three (3) pickett houses to the Papago Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council had a meeting on September 30, 1965, at which time the Council had a quorum present. The three (3) pickett houses were discussed, and

WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council voted unanimously to ask the Papago Tribal Council to turn over to them the three (3) pickett houses, provided the District assumes the responsibility of management, the upkeep of the houses and receives all revenue from rental from tenants of the houses.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it hereby accepts and approves the above Resolution, giving the Gu Achi District the three (3) pickett houses as provided in the terms above.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on November 12, 1965, with a vote of 21 for, 0 against and 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984.), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
