## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1506

WHEREAS, Chapter 1, Section 2, of the Papago Tribal Law and Order Code provides for the appointment of Associate Judges for the Papago Reservations, and

WHEREAS, provision is made for two Associate Judges but it has not been necessary to appoint a second Associate Judge, and

WHEREAS, it has now become imperative that another Associate Judge be appointed to serve when it is inconvenient for the first Associate Judge to serve, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has selected Edward Kisto, who is a member of the Papago Tribe and is a resident of Fresnel Canyon Village in Baboquivori District, for appointment as an Associate Judge.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it recommends to the Bureau of Indian Affairs that Edward Kisto be appointed as the second Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Court, to serve when his services are required at \$10 per day, or fraction thereof, and that  $10\phi$  per mile be paid for mileage from his village and back.

PROVIDED; that such pay and travel expenses shall be paid from Tribal Funds budgeted for the Associate Judges; and

PROVIDED FURTHER; that, in accordance with the provisions of the Papago Law and Order Code, such appointment shall be effective for a period of two (2) years.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on February 10, 1967 with a vote of 19 for and 0 against at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3(a), (b) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 12, 1937. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 16 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
