RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1516

WHEREAS, Floyd Garcia, a resident of the Sells community and a member of the Papago Indian Tribe, desires to establish a barber shop in the space now occupied by the Arts and Crafts Shop, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Garcia will need a fifteen year lease on the site to obtain federal financing for the establishment of the barber shop, and

WHEREAS, during the lease term, Mr. Garcia agrees to pay to the Papago Tribe a rental of five per cent (5%) of his gross business income, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Garcia has agreed that the basket shop will remain in its present location until such time as other space is made available for the sale of Papago arts and crafts, and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of the Papago Tribe to encourage and assist its members in pursuing opportunities that will result in employment and the development of one's skills to the highest possible degree.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby authorizes the granting of a fifteen year lease to Floyd Garcia for an annual rental of five per cent (5%) of his gross business income with the stipulation that the basket shop will remain in its present location until other space is made available for it and the Tribal officials are hereby ordered and directed to execute a fifteen year lease with Mr. Garcia on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on May 22, 1967, with a vote of 15 for, 0 against, with 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the
