RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1517

WHEREAS, on December 2, 1966, the Papago Tribal Council passed Resolution No. 1498, stating that the Baboquivori District determined that a lease should be granted to Edward N. Kiste for an indefinite time for his home, occupancy and beneficial use, and

WHEREAS, the Act of August 9, 1955, (69 Stat. 539) does not authorize the granting of leases on the Papago Reservation for indefinite periods of time but for terms of not to exceed 25 years with the right or option to renew for an additional term of not to exceed 25 years and

WHEREAS, Edward N. Kiste a resident of the Baboquivori District and a member of the Papago Tribe, requires a lease in order to obtain financing for the construction of his home,

WHEREAS, Mr. Kiste has selected and surveyed 40 acres of land in the Baboquivori District for his ranch.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Council hereby rescind Resolution No. 1498, and authorize the granting of a lease to Edward N. Kiste for a period of 25 years with an option to renew same for an additional term of 25 years in accordance with the act of 1955 Act. supra, and the regulations issued thereunder.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that rental rates for said lease shall be one dollar (\$1.00) for each 25 year term with payment to be made each term in advance.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on June 2, 1966 with a vote of 19 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the in the council by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
