RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1518

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has retained Shelby Atkinson as its accountant on a part-time basis, and

WHEREAS, Shelby Atkinson has worked diligently and competently in carrying out his duties as the Tribal accountant, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is desirous of retaining Atkinson for the next fiscal year beginning July 1, 1967, and ending June 30, 1968.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby retain Shelby Atkinson as Tribal Accountant for the period of July 1, 1967, and ending June 30, 1968, on a part-time basis for the salary of \$200.00 per month, plus mileage at the rate of ten cents (10¢) per mile.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council, on June 19, 1967, with a vote of 19 for, 0 against, with not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Sections 2 (f) and 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
