



The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on June 2, 1967, with a vote of 15 for, 0 against, with 1 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (1) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1523

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of May, 1967, bids were opened at the hour of 3:00 p.m. at the Papago Agency of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in Sells, for exclusive prospecting permits with option to lease, and

WHEREAS, the following were the high bonus amounts bid on the two tracts offered:

Tract No. 2

Pima Mining Company \$256,000.00

WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has recommended to the Tribal Council that it accept these bids, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Director of Mines, Vernon B. Smith, the Tribal Attorney, Edward B. Berger, the Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the United States Geological Survey have all agreed that these bids should be accepted.
