RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1526

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on June 9, 1967, at which a quorum was present, the Sells District Council approved a budget for the 1967 fiscal year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Sells District Budget for the 1967 fiscal year be approved as follows:

For Sells Village, to be used for what the Village considers necessary \$200.00

For Big Field, North Villages, to be used for what the Villages consider necessary 200.00

For Cowlic Village, to be used for what the Village considers necessary 200.00

Total: \$600.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer of the Sells District Council or his authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on June 16, 1967, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, with 3 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937 (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
