

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1528

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on June 2, 1967, at which a quorum was present, the Sif Oidak District Council approved a budget for the 1967 fiscal year and has submitted it to the Papago Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Sif Oidak District Budget for the 1967 fiscal year be approved as follows:

Gasoline & Oil, feed for live-stock, groceries for roundups, repairing water pumps, office supplies, lumber & bolts for corrals	\$2,000.00
Payments to Councilmen for District meetings	3,000.00
Gasoline and vehicle repairs to District meetings	3,000.00
District telephone	500.00
Electricity for water pumps	500.00
Boundary Fencing Repairs	5,000.00
Miscellaneous expenses	2,000.00
	<u>\$16,000.00</u>

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer of the Sif Oidak District Council or his authorized representative be permitted to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on June 16, 1967, with a vote of 18 for, 0 against, with 3 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the
