

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1562

WHEREAS, a new program known as Operation Mainstream has been created, and

WHEREAS, the program is for individuals twenty-two years of age and over, and

WHEREAS, said Operation Mainstream will be similar to the Neighborhood Youth Corps, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to do everything possible to provide the Papago people with opportunities to increase their education, vocational training and work experience in order to improve their living standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby directs the Papago Tribal Chairman to file an application with Operation Mainstream for funds to begin such a program on the Papago Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on November 3, 1967, with a vote of 20 for, 0 against, with 0 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Sections 2 (a) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934.
