

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1571

WHEREAS, George English, Jr., an employee of the Papago Agency has indicated an interest in leasing a 50' by 50' parcel of Tribal land adjacent to the Sells airstrip for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a hanger, and

WHEREAS, Mr. English has agreed to pay a rental of \$100.00 per year for said land on a five year lease with an option to renew for an additional five years, and

WHEREAS, Mr. English has agreed to transfer ownership of the said hanger to the Tribe upon expiration of the lease or upon transfer of Mr. English from the Papago Agency, and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the Papago Tribe to allow construction of the proposed hanger.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it hereby approves the application of George English, Jr., to lease a 50' by 50' parcel of Tribal land adjacent to the Sells airstrip for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a hanger. The Tribal Council hereby directs the Tribal Chairman and Secretary to enter into a lease with Mr. English for a five year period at a rental of \$100.00 per year with an option to renew said lease for an additional five year period.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Tribal Council on November 13, 1967, with a vote of 15 for, 0 against, with 0 not voting, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Sections 2 (f) and 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, (Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
