

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 27-69

WHEREAS; The Ak-Chin Farms of The Ak-Chin Indian Community, Route 1, Box 12, Maricopa, Arizona, 85239, has applied to The Papago Council for a permit to buy cattle on the Papago Reservation, and


WHEREAS; The Papago Council has considered the Ak-Chin Farms application and has determined that it would be of benefit to the Papago stockmen to grant such permit,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, that it hereby approves a cattle buyers permit to The Ak-Chin Farms of the Ak-Chin Indian Community.


The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on August 1, 1969, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, with a vote of 12 for, 0 against, 1 not voting, and 9 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(f) and Section 3(e) of Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by The Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona.
