WHEREAS; The Papago Tribe is continuing to expand its business ventures and activities, and

WHEREAS; Donald F. Duncan, Jr., has been employed as Business Manager by the Tribe under Agreement dated August 1, 1970, for the period beginning August 1, 1970, and ending June 30, 1971, and

WHEREAS; Mr. Duncan's contract with the Tribe expires on June 30, 1971, and Mr. Duncan has performed his duties under this contract proficiently and competently, and

WHEREAS; it is the desire of the Tribe to retain Duncan as Business
Manager for an additional two-year period beginning July 1, 1971, and
ending June 30, 1973,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that The Papago

Council hereby orders and directs the Tribal officials to enter into an Agreement with DONALD F. DUNCAN, JR., as Business Manager of The Papago

Tribe. A copy of said Agreement is attached hereto. In accordance with the terms and conditions of said annexed Agreement, the said Tribal officials are further ordered and directed to execute the annexed Agreement on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 18th day of May, 1971, with a vote of 20 for, against not voting, and 2 absent, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Sections 2(f) and 3(a) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe, ratified by The Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of The Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution

is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe.
