WHEREAS; the members of The Panago Council desire to fill the vacancy in such office to assist the Chairman of The Papago Council, and

WHEREAS; nominations for the office of Vice Chairman, were made, and

WHEREAS; an election was held,

YOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that Enos Francisco, Jr., is hereby elected to fill the vacancy of the office of Vice Chairman of The Papago Council until the next election.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 25th day of June, 1971, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 8 for Enos Francisco, Jr., 6 for his opponent, and 7 abstentions, and one absent, nursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 4 of Article III and Section 2(e) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe, ratified by The Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 1, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of The Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its signing by the Chairman of The Papago Council.
