

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 35-71

WHEREAS; the San Xavier Industrial Park is now ready for new industry to locate there, and

WHEREAS; new industry should be actively sought for the San Xavier Industrial Park, and

WHEREAS; Michael Enis has been authorized by Papago-Tucson Development Corporation's board of directors to travel to Chicago to interest an industrial firm to locate in the San Xavier Industrial Park,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that a resolution of the Board of Directors of Papago-Tucson Development Corporation authorizing Michael Enis to travel to Chicago, Illinois, to meet with an industrial firm as a prospect to locate at the San Xavier Industrial Park is hereby approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 16th day of July, 1971, with a vote of 20 for, -0- against, -0- not voting, and 2 absent, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by The Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of The Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
