

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 50-71

WHEREAS, the United States Army has leased a small site in the Sif Oidak District for some time under an aerial site marker lease; and

WHEREAS, the Army desires to use this site for identification markers used as measuring devices on U. S. Army maps; and

WHEREAS, said aerial marker lease expired June 1971; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army desires to renew this aerial site marker lease; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has suggested an increase in the leasing fees for this site; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes that a clause should be inserted in any such lease to the effect that said leased land may be reacquired by the Sif Oidak District at any time in the future should the District have a better use for said leased land;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the matter be returned to the Sif Oidak District Council for a decision as to the suggested increase in leasing fees and the clause to be inserted in any lease to be executed concerning the taking over of the leased land by the Sif Oidak District if a better use should be found for said leased land.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 23rd day of August, 1971, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, with a vote of 16 for, -0- against, 2 not voting, and 4 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(c) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of The Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

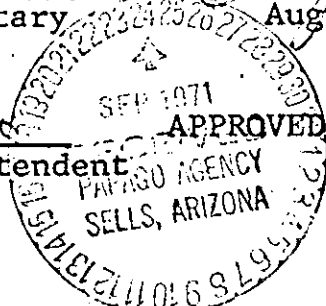
