and 36-71 concerning formation of a Committee to assist with preparation of the draft of an amended or revised Constitution; and

WHEREAS, it has now been brought to the attention of the Council that the revision of the Law & Order Code should be begun; and

WHEREAS, it has been suggested to the Council that the Committee for revision of the Constitution and the Committee for the Law and Order Code revision should consist of the same members and that the two Committees be merged into one Committee; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of The Papago Tribe to authorize the merger of these two Committees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED-BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL:

1. That the Committee for revision of the Constitution and the Committee for revision of the Law and Order Code be merged into one Committee and that the following members of The Tribe beappointed to said Committee:

RAY NARCHO
ARCHIE HENDRICKS, SR.
LAMONDO FRANCISCO
EUGENE TASQUINTH

2. That the Committee is hereby instructed to begin work on revision of the Law and Order Code immediately, as this is to be the first order of the business of the Committee.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 12th day of November, 1971, with a vote of 11 for, 9 against, 2 not voting, and -0- absent, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by The Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1936. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
