RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 86-71

WHEREAS: The OEO programs on the Papago Reservation are trying to meet the needs of the Papago people.

WHEREAS: These OEO programs are; therefore, desirable and necessary.

WHEREAS: The OEO administrative office has done everything possible to assure the continuing of these programs.

WHEREAS: The decision to continue these programs has been made and funds have been approved.

WHEREAS: Due to bureaucratic delay in the OEO office in Washington new funds are being delayed even though old funds have been expended:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Papago Council fully support the OEO programs on the Papago Reservation.

That the Papago Council authorize the OEO administration office to take whatever measures may be necessary to obtain immediate release of approved funds and to assure that such bureaucratic delay will not continue to prevent full operation of OEO programs on the Papago Reservation.

That in order to meet immediate fiscal needs as they may arise, the Papago Community Action Program is hereby authorized to borrow funds in the name of the Papago Tribe provided as follows:

Any obligation incurred pursuant to this resolution shall be in the form of a note payable thirty days from making.

Total indebtedness under this resolution shall not exceed \$15,000

Any funds received from OEO or HEW for the purpose of funding programs under the Papago Community Action Program shall be available to retire any such indebtedness and shall first be used to reture such indebtedness.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 7, 1971 at a meeting of which a quorum was present by a vote of 18 for and 0 against, 2 not voting, and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws

of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
