

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RESOLUTION NO. 1-72

WHEREAS, the election of District Councilmen and the general election for officials of The Papago Tribe will be held early in 1972; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council encourages all of the Papago people to participate in their government and its activities; and

WHEREAS, the attached election procedure has been used for previous election in 1970; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of all concerned to adopt the attached election procedure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the election procedure, as set forth on the attached, is hereby adopted by The Papago Council.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 21st day of December, 1971, with a vote of 17 for, -0- against, 2 not voting and 3 absent, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2(f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency.
