

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 5-72

WHEREAS; a comprehensive study of the existing road system has been made on the Papago reservation, together with recommendations for priority improvements and upgrading of routes with increasing traffic requirements; and

WHEREAS; many of the roads are necessary for uninterrupted school busing traffic to transport children from remote areas to day school facilities; and

WHEREAS; the economic development of remote areas will require improved road systems; and

WHEREAS; the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads has requested authority to perform preliminary surveys for road improvements, and relocations, road material exploration and water requirement studies; and

WHEREAS; the requested surveys and studies are in the best interests of all members of the Papago reservation in developing a more complete and adequate road system;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL; that the Bureau of Indian Affairs Branch of Roads is hereby authorized and requested to conduct surveys and studies herein applied for the future benefit and development of the Papago reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Chairman of The Papago Council and the Superintendent of the Papago Agency are hereby authorized and empowered to execute right-of-way permits for construction as needed to carry out the Papago Master Road Plan.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 03 day of March 1972, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 19 for, 0 against, 1 not voting, and 5 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(a)(d) and Sec 3(h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, as amended April 9, 1960, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.

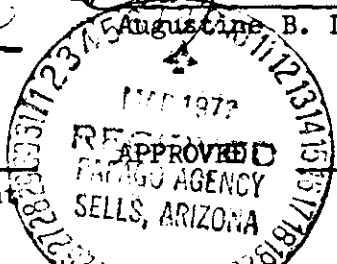
