

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 9-72

WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District has presented two resolutions to the Papago Council in which the District (1) requests approval for reimbursement of \$189.00 to Ramon Chavez for the purchase of well pump parts, and (2) requests approval for its budget for Fiscal Year 1971-1972 totalling \$3,600 with special focus on the use of oil, fuel and electricity for wells in the Chukut Kuk District; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council finds these requests to be in order;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the two resolutions of the Chukut Kuk District, as set forth above, be and are hereby approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 3rd day of March, 1972, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 18 for, -0- against, 2 not voting and 2 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of The Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency.
