

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 13-72

WHEREAS, there has been presented to The Papago Council a request concerning the Districts' participation in the Commodity Food Program; and

WHEREAS, it would appear that only Gila Bend and San Xavier might possibly be excepted from the Commodity Food Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that all Districts will participate in the Commodity Food Program with the possible exceptions of Gila Bend and San Xavier.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 14th day of March, 1972, with a vote of 17 for, -4- against, -0- not voting, and 1 absent, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Article V, Section 2(f) of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat.984) pursuant to Section 16 of The Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency.
