

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 15-72

WHEREAS, The CHR program is in urgent need of vehicles to administer the health services, and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to purchase vehicles costing approximately \$26,000 from CHR contract funds and trade-in of old vehicles,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the purchase of vehicles for the CHR program is approved and the time financing of any unpaid balance, is guaranteed by The Papago Tribe to the First National Bank of Arizona.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 7 day of April 1972 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 16 for, 0 against, 1 not voting, and 5 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe, ratified by The Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by The Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of The Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
