WHEREAS, the Papago Council at its meeting on the 7th day of April, 1972 resolved by Resolution #15-72 to approve the time payment of vehicles for the CHR Program, and

WHEREAS, said Resolution omitted to specify who was empowered to sign corresponding documents on behalf of the Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Tribal Chairman, Mr. Augustine B. Lopez and the Tribal Treasurer, Mrs. JoAnn Francisco, are hereby empowered to sign the corresponding documentation pertaining to this purchase.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the ______ day of _______, 1972 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of _______ for, _______ against, ______ not voting, and ________ 2___ absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe, ratified by The Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by The Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of The Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
