

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 30-72

WHEREAS, The Papago Council judges that at this time the continuation of the commodity distribution program is in the best interest of the Papago people (excepting those residing in the San Xavier and San Lucy Districts)

WHEREAS, The decision of the State of Arizona to cease to distribute commodities on August 30, 1972 makes it mandatory that a separate program be developed and put in operation with all possible speed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

- 1) That the Papago Council reaffirms its decision of March 10, 1972 (Resolution No.13-72) that the commodity program is to be continued (excepting San Xavier and San Lucy Districts).
- 2) That the Papago Planning Department is instructed to plan and implement a Papago commodity distribution system and to pursue all available resources necessary to that end.
- 3) That the planning and implementation of a Papago commodity distribution program is a priority for all Tribal departments and that all departments will therefore assist the Planning Department as needed.
- 4) That the Papago Planning Department will report on its progress including all projected local costs of the Papago commodity distribution system at the next meeting of the Papago Council and subsequent meetings thereof.
