

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO 31-72

WHEREAS, there has been presented to The Papago Council a request for acceptance into membership in The Papago Tribe by Blevins Lopez, one-half Papago and one-half San Juan Pueblo, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Louis R. Lopez, enrolled members of The Papago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, Blevins Lopez wishes to be adopted as a member of The Papago Tribe;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that Blevins Lopez, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Louis R. Lopez, is hereby welcomed as a member of The Papago Tribe.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Blevins Lopez's name be added to the Roll.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 2nd day of June, 1972, at a meeting at which a quorum was present by a vote of 22 for, -0- against, -0- not voting, and -0- absent. The Resolution is in full authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 1(a) and Article II and Section 2(m) of Article V of the Constitution of The Papago Tribe ratified by The Papago Tribe on December 1, 1984, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1984, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
