

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 56-72

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 18-72 The Papago Council created the Educational Financial Aid Committee to assist Josiah Moore in the areas of preparation of budget and investigation of availability of grants for education of Indian students; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 29-72 The Papago Council amended Resolution No. 18-72 regarding the Educational Financial Aid Committee; and

WHEREAS, it has now been suggested to the Council that the Educational Financial Aid Committee be retired and that the duties originally assigned to that Committee be assumed by the Fiscal Committee; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council deems it to be in the best interests of the Tribe that the suggestion be put into effect,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the Educational Financial Aid Committee be and is hereby dissolved and that the duties of said Committee be assigned to the Fiscal Committee, which will henceforth handle all financial matters concerning the Education Department.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 29th day of September, 1972, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 15 for, -0- against, 6 not voting, and 1 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency.
