

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 68-72

WHEREAS, the firm of Desert Photographics has requested permission to film the Papago Rodeo during the 1972 event; and

WHEREAS, the photographic firm has also requested permission to photograph the "every day life" of a Papago family; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council deems it within the area of the Council's authority to give permission to Desert Photographics to photograph the rodeo; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Council that permission to photograph any family member should be granted by the individual Papago;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that


1. Permission is granted to Desert Photographics for the filming of the 1972 rodeo to be held at Sells during November 1972; and
2. Permission to photograph individual Papagos and their families must be granted by the individual Papago.


The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 3rd day of November, 1972, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 16 for, 0 against, 2 not voting, and 4 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (1) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
