WHEREAS, The Papago Council has authorized the Papago Housing Authority to operate with a full complement of five members plus a chairman of the all-Papago Housing Authority; and

WHEREAS, by the enactment of Resolutions 60-72 and 67-72 The Papago Council recognized the efforts of the Papago Housing Authority to bring its membership up to its full complement once again; and

WHEREAS, The appointment of Mary Hoffman to the Papago Housing Authority has been recommended by Hilda Garcia; and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council deems the appointment of Mary Hoffman to be in the best interests of the Housing Authority and of the Tribe;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that MARY HOFFMAN be, and hereby is, appointed to the membership of the Papago Housing Authority for a term of _________, effective immediately.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the 1st day of December, 1972, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 20 for, 0 against, 2 not voting, and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
