

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 73-72

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of The Papago Council that the Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEPE) has been operating without a director since Raymond Lopez had been suspended as TWEPE Director; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Council that Raymond Lopez should be reinstated as TWEPE Director, effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, the Council retains its right to suspend Raymond Lopez should he fail to properly execute his duties as TWEPE Director;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that Raymond Lopez be, and he hereby is, reinstated as Director of the Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEPE), effective immediately, but said reinstatement is subject to Mr. Lopez's proper execution of the duties of his office.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1st day of December, 1972, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 7 for, 2 against, 11 not voting, and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984), pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
