

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 11-73

WHEREAS: The Papago Nutrition Improvement Program and the Papago Emergency Food Program have the same basic objective of combating hunger and malnutrition among the Papago people,

WHEREAS: There is a need to coordinate planning, supervision and the search for continued funding, and

WHEREAS: The Papago Nutrition Improvement Program is best equipped by administrative and profession staff to guide and direct both programs, and


WHEREAS: Both the OEO Advisory Board, the Nutrition Board and the Executive Health Staff have recommended that the two programs be combined under the direction of the Papago Nutrition Program.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, that the Council supports the continuation of the Papago Nutrition Improvement Program and the Emergency Food Program and directs that both programs shall henceforth be operated jointly under the administration of the Papago Nutrition Improvement Program Director and Board as part of the Papago Executive Health Staff.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on March 2, 1973, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 22 for, 0 against, and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V, of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as to the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to the review by the Secretary of the Interior.
