

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 13-73

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has five community center buildings, EDA project 05-1-00495, that have been approved for construction, and

WHEREAS, inflationary prices have caused the construction costs of the building to exceed the amount of the EDA funds available for construction, and

WHEREAS, the economic position of the Papago Tribe prohibits the additional use of Tribal funds to supplant the construction costs, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Construction Department can build the five community buildings by force account at a cost considerably less than the cost of construction under normal competitive bidding and

WHEREAS, it maybe possible for the Tribal Construction Department to build all five of the buildings with the present funds available, and

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is aware of the possibility that construction costs maybe greater than the total funds and as a result all five structures may not be constructed, and the Tribe is willing to establish a priority system for the construction of the buildings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

The the Papago Council hereby requests the Economic Development Administration to allow the Papago Tribe, through the Construction Department to force account the five community buildings, EDA Project 05-1-00495, under a priority system to be established by the Papago Council and the five districts involved.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on April 2, 1973 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 21 for, 0 against, 1 not voting and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in The Papago Council by Section 2(d) of Article V of the Constitution and By Laws of The Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by The Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of The Papago Agency and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
