

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 47-73

WHEREAS, The Student Body of Baboquivari High School has requested the permission of the Council to paint a large "B" in one of the hills in the Baboquivari District; and

WHEREAS, This type of school emblem has been permitted by many of the schools and colleges outside the reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Student Body of Baboquivari High School is authorized to paint a "B" on a selected hill in the Baboquivari District to represent our Reservation High School.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the twentieth day of July 1973, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of fifteen for zero against zero not voting and seven absent, pursuant to authority contained in Article V, Section 2 (f), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as on the date of approval by the Papago Agency Superintendent and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
