WHEREAS, The Hickiwan District does not have an alternate for its councilman; and

WHEREAS, The District is desirous of designating Juan Lee Thomas as alternate for that District.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council approves the appointment of Juan Lee Thomas as alternate to the Hickiwan District Councilman.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by The Papago Council on the <u>third</u> day of <u>August</u> 1973, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>sixteen</u> for, <u>zero</u> against, <u>zero</u> not voting and <u>six</u> absent, pursuant to authority contained in Article III of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said resolution is effective as on the date of approval by the Papago Agency Superintendent and is not subject to review by the Secretary.
